Review into taxation and corporate whistleblowing protections

The Westpac Group (**Westpac**) appreciates the opportunity to provide comments to the Treasury 'Review of tax and corporate whistleblower protections in Australia' dated 20 December 2016 (**the 'review**'). We note that submissions to the review will be provided to the Parliamentary Joint Committee on the Corporations and Financial Services inquiry into whistleblower protections in the corporate, public and not-for-profit sectors.

Westpac supports the underlying principles of the review. We have contributed to, and support, the submission being made by the Australian Bankers' Association (**ABA**).
