I am writing to insist that the Taskforce recognises that there is no safety for the general public using the current banking system as a way of protecting our hard earned savings.

The banking system was exposed for what it is at the Banking Royal Commission and the governments response has been disgraceful as the system remains unchanged.

The government's apparent support of the banks wishes to remove cash from the economy and to trap us in the private banking system is very worrying and cannot be allowed to continue to happen.

The direct evidence that is on record in regards to de-banking especially cash businesses and the removal of banking services from rural, regional and urban areas proves that the banks are not interested in customer service banking.

The banks' obsession with profit and greed, which sees them gambling with derivatives and speculative vehicles is again direct evidence of their contempt for the safety of their customer's funds and will ultimately be the cause of the loss of customer's funds, due to the bail in laws that have been passed in parliament.

The status quo cannot continue as it is. Action needs to be taken now to protect Australians and the Australian economy.

When Bob Katter's Commonwealth Postal Savings Bank Bill is introduced into parliament, my family and I insist that the Regional Banking Taskforce and all elected members of parliament support the bill to enable a path for the changes necessary to protect and ensure banking services to all Australians.
